I was living in a local village. One very compassionate lady was visiting & feeding me since I was born. Always she told the owner “Don’t sell him” One day the owner sold me. I was moved to another village, then sold again to a Muslim man.



Not looking good... Indeed, shortly thereafter, I was in a place of confinement on the border of Bangladesh. Conversations around me let me know that we were all intended for slaughter. After being there 2 days, that lady who fed me in my village, she came.! She cried. She begged. She finally paid double the price for my release. She had no place in her home to keep me...What was she going to do? Smart lady! She brought me to a nice man who had many cows and bulls. Now, since a few days ago, I am again with his cows and bulls. I will be happy here. There is fodder and water, and shade over my head.

Are you afraid of me? Some people are.



Let me tell you my story. I was tied next to my mother while the Ghosh was taking her milk. After 1 year, she had no more milk, so they sent me away from my house. I was scared, alone. I didn’t know where was food. By the road, in the field, I was just trying to get some grass. Instead I was harassed, chased and beaten. Once one person hit me with a burning iron rod. Like that 3-4 years have passed. I survived. **I even got stronger, but I lost my trust in humans.** Finally, in one village, it came to such a crisis that many men attacked together and tied me down with so many ropes. **Even my neck rope was tied to my legs.** Can you imagine? After 3 days in this miserable condition, these kind people came and gave me water and fodder. I just knew they were different...good people. My ropes were loosened. Quickly a truck came. I trusted them enough to get in! Now my trust in humans is increasing. When things are settled here, come and visit me, I like bananas, bread and vegetables

My dear friend Nanda Mahārāja, in the place where you are living with your friends, is the forest favorable for the animals, the cows? I hope there is no disease or inconvenience. The place must be full of water, grass and other plants. SB. 10.5.26
